



## Membership fee

<p><b>WHAT do I get for my membership fee?</b></p> <p>You will as a member</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Have access to a local Europe-wide professional network</li> <li>• Have access to the Association's website (members section)</li> <li>• Have access to the membership database</li> <li>• Read <b>proActive</b>, our European magazine both online and in paper edition</li> <li>• Have the opportunity to participate in a custom-made Training Programme</li> <li>• Participate in the Annual General Meeting and Annual Conference organised by different National Groups</li> <li>• Participate in an annual programme of national and cross-border events</li> <li>• Have up-to-date information regarding different profession and job-related developments.</li> </ul> <p><b>HOW do I pay my membership fee?</b></p> <p>You belong to a European Association, but are linked administratively via your National Group. So you will pay your membership fee to your National Treasurer (<i>to know who your National Treasurer is, click on the National Page on our website</i>). If no Group exists in your home country you pay your membership fee directly to the European Central Fund via our European Treasurer (<i>to know who our current European Treasurer is click on About Us / European Committee on our website</i>). Your National Treasurer (or the European Treasurer, if you are not linked to a National Group) will send you a reminder every year.</p>	<p><b>WHEN do I have to pay my membership fee?</b></p> <p>Your membership fee is payable once a year, by 28th February.</p> <p><b>HOW MUCH is my yearly membership fee?</b></p> <p>The membership fee is actually composed of two parts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A contribution to the European Central Fund decided by the European Annual General Meeting</li> <li>• An additional fee in order to cover national running expenses decided by each National Group in its Annual General Meeting.</li> </ul> <p>Please refer to your National Treasurer to know how much your annual membership fee is, according to your type of membership.</p> <p><b>If there were not a EUMA Group in my home country, how much would my membership fee be?</b></p> <p>In this case you are an <i>Individual Member</i> and you will not be able to participate in the varied activities the National Groups arrange locally for their members. Therefore you only have to pay a contribution to the European Central Fund via the European Treasurer.</p> <p>The European Treasurer will inform you of the current contribution fee and our bank details. The fees must be paid by bank transfer.</p>
